Key Tasks and Responsibilities

2. Develop and deliver consistently engaging and interactive sessions, utilising a variety of teaching techniques and materials to enhance learners' understanding and engagement with the subject or topic.
3. Assess learners' abilities and identify areas for improvement, tailoring teaching and learning methods and resources accordingly.
4. Provide individualised support to learners, addressing their specific learning needs and challenges through one-on-one meetings and additional learning resources.
5. Monitor and track learners' progress, providing regular feedback and implementing strategies to address areas of weakness or underperformance.
6. Establish and maintain a positive and inclusive learning environment, actively promoting learner participation, motivation, and confidence in professional development.
7. Maintain accurate records of learners' attendance, progress, and assessment outcomes, ensuring compliance with PATH Yorkshire's requirements.
