English short courses will require curriculum and learning resources development.

Learners for ESOL/English at PATH Yorkshire are ages 19 years and above.

Key Tasks and Responsibilities

- 1. Plan and deliver interactive ESOL/English learning sessions, covering speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills.
- 2. Assessing learners' initial English level, identifying personal learning goals, and developing an Individual Learning Plan with the learners.
- 3. Evaluate learners' progress through formative assessments, providing timely and constructive feedback and guidance.
- 4. Create and adapt learning materials, including Schemes of Learning, handouts, and assessments.
- 5. Establishing and maintaining a supportive and inclusive learning environment that encourages participation, motivation, and confidence.
- 6. Maintaining accurate records of learner attendance, progress, and assessment outcomes, while adhering to relevant regulations and policies.
- 7. Complete programme documentation and evidencing requirements on time, keeping track of due dates, while in compliance with the quality standards.
- 8. Contribute to the development and improvement of PATH Yorkshire's ESOL programmes.
- 9. Regular reporting of course and learners' progress to Line Manager.
- 10. Other responsibilities which may be assigned by the Line Manager.
